### **Inland Technologies Canada Inc. Marks the Completion of Their Halifax Glycol Distillation Plant**

**October 14, 2015 (Enfield, Nova Scotia)** – Halifax International Airport is set to stake their claim on the leading edge of winter resilience with the commissioning of Inland Technologies Canada Incorporated's (Inland) new glycol distillation plant.

Employees and distinguished guests gathered at the site today to mark the completion of Inland's recent plant expansion with an Open House event.

"The upcoming winter season will mark the 20th year of operation for Inland at the Halifax Airport," says Roger Langille, Inland CEO. "With this expansion, we're making a huge impact on the airport's environmental footprint."

Going forward, spent glycol generated from the airport's aircraft de-icing operations will be collected, recycled and re-manufactured into Type I aircraft de-icing fluid (ADF) for distribution and re-use at the airport. Inland collects seven million liters of glycol-impacted stormwater per season, sixty-three million liters total since their on-site operation began.

Construction to expand the Halifax facility started in 2014 and included the addition of Inland's Starcevic Distillation System™, a plant that processes the recovered glycol impacted stormwater to a near virgin quality product suitable for re-use in a range of industrial processing including ADF.

Inland added blending equipment to produce Inland's Type I ADF which is fully certified and is completely manufactured from re-claimed glycol. Their blending unit is capable of producing up to 15,000 liters per day. "Since our operations are at the airport, we are able to offer increased reliability of ADF," says Langille, "Especially during extended periods of inclement weather."

Inland will continue to work closely with the airport community in developing programs and infrastructure to help further improve sustainability. As the company continues to look to the future, plans for new products and improvements on existing technologies.
